Fine Artist

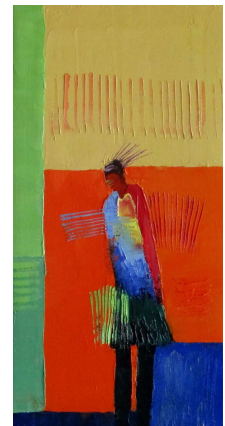
Timothy A. Genet is an artist born and raised in Southern California. Interested in art at a young age he had very little exposure or formal training.
