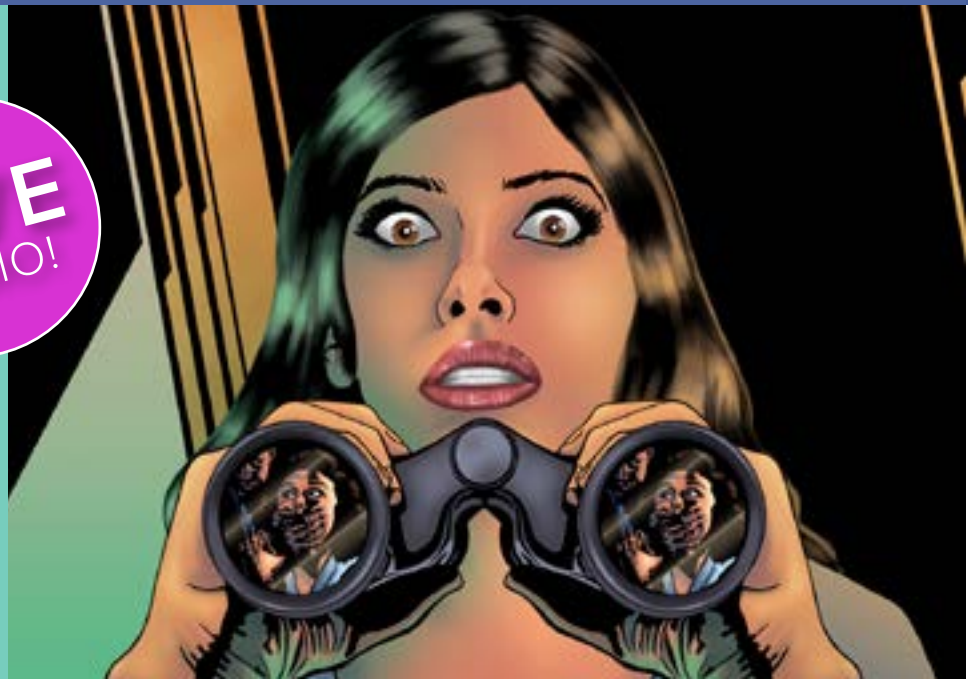

Christopher DeFelippo is a digital artist who creates original artwork influenced by Noir Films, Popular Culture and Comic books under the name Digital Noir Studios.

He is an academy award nominated artist and Grammy award winning Designer. Christopher got his start working for Marvel Comics as an artist and editor while still in college. This is where he honed his skill and art style by working with the masters in the field like Stan Lee, John Romita, Frank Miller and many more. From there he worked for Disney Animation on the feature film Hunchback of Notre Dame (Multiple Awards) and Disney Interactive Video Game Adaptation. Chris worked across Multiple Entertainment studios, including Sony Image Works and 20th Century Fox where he had the opportunity to work on several academy award nominated films as a visual and storyboard artist. From there Chris landed the role of Head Creative Director for Warner Brother Studios Music Division where he had the opportunity to worked across multiple music genres and a variety of artist role which led to being nominated and winning several Grammy awards for Designer. Currently Microsoft Chief Storyteller where his skills as an artist and storyteller have come together to show the world the future of technology and industries.
